## D – Due Process and Fairness

### กระบวนการทางกฎหมายที่ชอบและเป็นธรรม

Ensuring that legal procedures are proper and just,  
guaranteeing equal access to justice and  
equitable treatment under the law.

These principles are **interconnected** and **mutually reinforcing**.

Rights **(R)** are protected

through the impartial and accountable application of law **(O)**,

under a legitimate legal framework **(L)**,

implemented fairly through proper procedures **(D)**.
